TRAVELING TO SINGAPORE

Flights are available from many international destinations to **Singapore Changi Airport** (approximately 22 km/14 mi. from the Grand Hyatt Singapore).

VISA AND PASSPORT REQUIREMENTS

All visitors to Singapore must have a passport that is valid for more than six months at the time of departure. Delegates holding passports of all European Union countries, Australia, New Zealand, Switzerland and the United States are not required to have a visa to enter Singapore for stays of up to 30 days.
